WORK CONTINUES AS BOARD ARRANGEMENTS PROGRESS

Earlier this year, a regional subsidiary known as the Brown Hill and Keswick Creeks Stormwater Board was established by the five catchment councils to assume responsibility for the construction, management and ongoing maintenance of flood mitigation works as part of the Brown Hill Keswick Creek Stormwater Project.

The new Board will act on behalf of the five catchment councils to manage the implementation of the approved Brown Hill Keswick Creek Stormwater Management Plan.

Advertising for Board member positions recently concluded, with successful applicants expected to be selected and endorsed by councils by August.

In the meantime, project works are progressing on detailed design of stormwater detention basins incorporating a wetland in the South Park Lands. Engineering consultant Tonkin and Associates was awarded this contract in April, with designs due for completion later this year.

Elsewhere, Mitcham Council has invited tenders for construction of the Brown Hill Creek upgrade through Soldiers Memorial Gardens in Hawthorn.
