Victoria Park /Pakapakanthi (Park 16) Wetland

Update

Update

With the group of poplar trees in the south east corner of Victoria Park/Pakapakanthi (Park 16) removed, the project team is now focusing on making sure the site is ready for the main construction works to commence on the Wetland.

A tender process is underway to appoint a construction contractor by late 2020 / early 2021.

What's next?

The construction site fencing will start to go up in early December, and works will commence with the establishment of a large stockpile area where the soil removed to create the Wetland can be stored and sorted.

The construction of the Wetland will then follow in early 2021.

Access

The construction of the Wetland will take up a large area, meaning that some paths and equipment at the southern end of Park 16 will not be available during this time. We will provide signage on site to advise you of safe alternate routes and detours.

Trucks

The construction team will mostly access the site from Fullarton Road, with some access required from Beaumont Road (from Greenhill Road end).

We encourage you to keep your dog on leash if you are walking along the section of path next to Fullarton Road.
